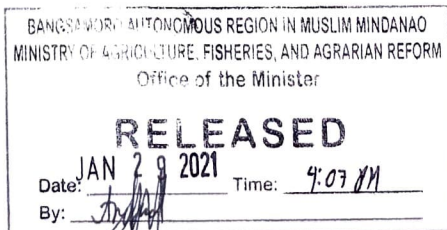
Anent this, the following are the objectives of the training:
